General admission requirements for applicants to the University of Saskatchewan from Nigeria include completion of West African Examinations Council Senior School Certificate

Applicants must have achieved a minimum average of 5 in:

- A first language Literature/Composition
- Mathematics
- Three additional academic subjects (Business and Agriculture courses are not acceptable subjects)

Prerequisite Subjects for each College:

Applicants must also have the subjects required for their college of choice

4. Examination Year (month/year)
5. Card Serial Number found on the reverse side of your Scratch card.
6. 10-digit Personal Identification Number (PIN) on your Scratch card
7. Your permission to look at your file
