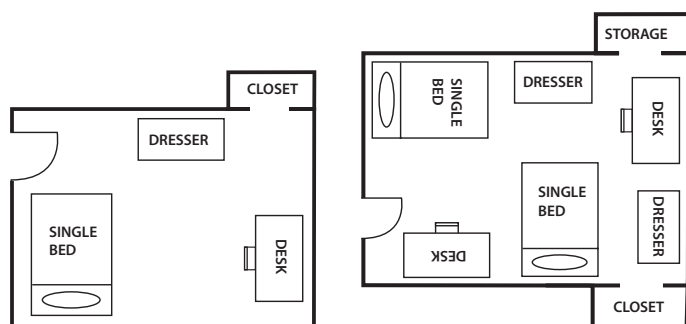


# Choosing Accommodations

There are seven residence options on or near campus, and students are encouraged to tour the ones they find appealing. The USSU offers an online housing registry that assists students seeking off-campus housing in Saskatoon.

**Voyageur Place** is an on-campus, four-building, dormitory-style complex that houses over 500 students and provides a meal plan.

**Luther Residence** is a non-smoking, non-drinking residence with single rooms for up to 20 students. A meal plan is provided.

**Mohyla Institute** offers fully furnished rooms for 50 students and provides a meal plan.

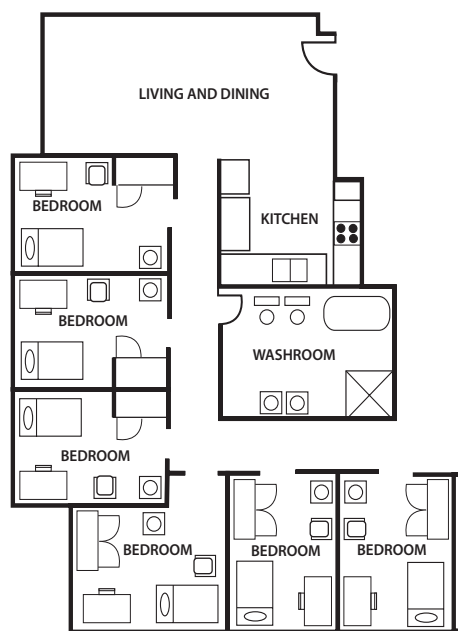
**Ogle Hall** houses 50 students in 47 single rooms and one three-bedroom suite. A meal plan is provided.

**St. Andrew's Residence** has 18 single rooms.

**Sheptytsky Institute**, a non-drinking, non-smoking residence, offers up to 60 students fully-furnished rooms and a meal plan.

**McEown Park** consists of multiple residence options:

- **Assiniboine/Wollaston Halls** have one- or two-bedroom apartment-style accommodation for students and couples without children. (Not available to first-year students.)
- **Seager Wheeler** has six-bedroom furnished apartments sharing a common kitchen, dining room and washroom.
- **Souris Hall** provides accommodation for families in unfurnished two-bedroom apartments.
