

# Admission Requirements

## 1. Graduation from high school

You may apply for admission in the year you will graduate if you provide your most up-to-date report card or transcript, as well as a list of classes/subjects you will complete prior to graduation.

## 2. Admission average

For students with no previous post-secondary education (fewer than 18 transferable credit units), an admission average is calculated using marks for five acceptable Grade 12 (senior-level) subjects:

1	Mathematics
1	English
3	Other acceptable Grade 12 (senior-level) subjects from the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Maximum of TWO natural sciences</li><li>▪ Maximum of TWO social sciences or humanities</li><li>▪ Maximum of ONE fine or performing art</li></ul>

### ROLLING ADMISSION

Applications are considered throughout the admissions cycle and admission is offered on a first-qualified, first-accepted basis.

### COMPETITIVE RANKING-BASED ADMISSION

Applicants will be ranked competitively by admission average and spaces will be offered to the top applicants.

Early admission may be offered to Edwards School of Business, Engineering and Kinesiology applicants who apply, pay the application fee, and submit transcripts and other documents required to consider the applicant for admission by December 1 and who meet the minimum average requirement for early admission.
