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PREREQUISITE U OF S COURSES

Elementary/Middle Years:

- Six credit units of introductory English
- Three credit units of Indigenous Studies
- Three credit units of Mathematics or Statistics
- Three credit units of Science
- Three credit units of Social Sciences
- Three credit units of Fine Arts
- Kin 121.3 or 122.3 or 146.3
- Six credits of open electives
- Teaching Area 1*:
a minimum of 18 credit units
- Teaching Area 2*:
a minimum of 12 credit units

Secondary:

- Six credit units of introductory English
- Three credit units of Indigenous Studies
- 12 credit units of open electives
- Teaching Area 1*:
a minimum of 24 credit units
- Teaching Area 2*:
a minimum of 15 credit units

*If any of the prerequisite courses are part of Teaching Area 1 or 2, the courses are replaced with open electives.

RECOMMENDED HIGH SCHOOL COURSES

Mathematics and science courses may be required depending on choice of elementary/middle years or secondary streams, as well as students' chosen Teaching Areas.

While a four-year direct-entry admission option is now available, the sequential (non-direct entry) option for upper-year students will still be offered in 2017-18 as the college transitions to the direct entry model. To be considered for admission to the sequential elementary/middle years or secondary education programs, applicants must complete a minimum of 60 credit units of university-level coursework, including the prerequisite courses listed above. An admission score will be calculated based on: grade point average calculated on the 60 credit units of prerequisite courses (50%), online interview (25%), and referee work experience evaluation from 35-40 hours of experience working with children (paid or unpaid) (25%).
