Through our admission policies, specialized scholarships and advanced credit offerings, we can help you get a start on your future.

ADVANCED CREDIT

Up to 30 credit units, the equivalent of one full year of post-secondary study, may be applied to your uSask degree.

- Most Higher Level (HL) subjects with grades of 5 or higher = 6 credit units
- Some Standard Level (SL) subjects with grades of 5 or higher = 3 credit units

We grant credit for the Extended Essay and Theory of Knowledge (TOK).

- Extended Essay = 3 credit units Junior General Humanities
- Theory of Knowledge = 6 credit units Junior Philosophy

Students completing the IB Diploma Programme are considered for admission based on a total score out of 45 possible points. Completion of the IB Diploma Programme also meets uSask's English language proficiency requirement for admission.

International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme Excellence Awards

CANADIAN STUDENTS \$5,000

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS \$15,000

Consideration is automatic for students completing the IB Diploma Programme who apply for admission by Feb. 15. Selection is based on academic achievement.

United World College (UWC) Excellence Awards

\$20,000

Consideration is automatic for students completing the IB Diploma Programme at a United World College who apply for admission by Feb. 15. Selection is based on academic achievement.

Guaranteed Entrance Scholarships

UP TO \$3,000

You will automatically be considered for a Guaranteed Entrance Scholarship when you apply for admission, based on your predicted/anticipated IB score. If your final score is higher, your scholarship amount may increase, as well!

Best and Brightest Entrance Scholarships

UP TO \$40,000

Apply for admission by Dec. 1 and apply for these awards by Dec. 15 to be considered. Selection is based on academics and/or leadership and contributions to school and community life.

Competitive Entrance Awards

UP TO \$32,000

Apply for admission by Feb. 15 and apply for these awards by Mar. 1 to be considered. These awards may be offered based on academic achievement, financial need and/or contributions to school and community life.
